To direct the heads of certain agencies to review and submit to Congress a report on public-private partnerships for combating the illicit fentanyl trade, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REVIEW AND REPORT ON PUBLIC-PRIVATE**
4 **PARTNERSHIPS TO COMBAT ILLICIT**
5 **FENTANYL.**

6 (a) REVIEW.—The heads of the agencies described in
7 subsection (b) (and in the case of the intelligence commu-

1 nity, the Director of National Intelligence) shall review,
2 respectively, the public-private partnerships of each such
3 agency for combating the illicit fentanyl trade.

4 (b) AGENCIES DESCRIBED.—The agencies described
5 in this subsection are the following:

6 (1) The Department of State.

7 (2) The Department of the Treasury.

8 (3) The Department of Defense.

9 (4) The Department of Justice.

10 (5) The Department of Commerce.

11 (6) The Department of Health and Human
12 Services.

13 (7) The Department of Transportation.

14 (8) The Department of Energy.

15 (9) The Department of Homeland Security.

16 (10) The intelligence community (as defined in
17 section 3(4) of the National Security Act of 1947
18 (50 U.S.C. 3003(4))).

19 (11) The United States Postal Service.

20 (c) REPORTING.—

21 (1) INITIAL REPORT.—Not later than 30 days
22 after the date of enactment of this Act, the heads
23 of the agencies described in subsection (b) shall sub-
24 mit to Congress a report describing the results of
25 the review under subsection (a), including—

1 (A) an assessment of the public-private
2 partnerships and their effectiveness; and

3 (B) a description of any key gaps.

4 (2) UPDATES.—Every 6 months following the
5 date of the submission of the report under sub-
6 section (c), the heads of the agencies described in
7 subsection (b) shall submit to Congress an update to
8 such report.

9 (3) FORM.—The reports and updates under
10 this subsection shall be submitted in unclassified
11 form but may include a classified annex.
